Dipaleseng Local Municipality concluded an intensive community program wherein eligible and qualifying members of the community to offer them an opportunity to enjoy the benefits of government funded subsidies on their consumer accounts.

This program allowed eligible community members to access this service at their doorstep, whereby Ward Councilors, supported by municipal officials, ward committee members, and community development workers, held sectoral sessions within the six municipal wards for this purpose.

The main purpose of indigent register implementation is to ensure that households with no or low income have access to basic services. 
