

## NEW RATES AND TARRIFS FOR MUNCIPAL SERVICES

# **EFFECTIVE DATE 1 JULY 2025**

Notice is hereby given to the rate payers and consumers in terms of section 13 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 2000 that Dipaleseng Local Municipality has by council resolution approved 2025/2026 Medium-Term Revenue and Expenditure Framework (MTREF) for levying a rate on propertyard service charges. The tariffs were approved by the Council on **28<sup>th</sup> May 2025** - Council resolution number **C140/05/25.** It is important to note that electricity tariffs are subject to the approval of NERSA.
